Recipe of the Month

Slow Cooker Apple Butter

Ingredients:

- 12 Apples, peeled, cored, cubed
- 2 C. Brown Sugar
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground allspice
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp ground cloves

Instructions:

- Combine all ingredients and place in slow cooker
- 2. Cook on high for 4-6 hours, until apples are tender
- 3. Puree apple mixture in immersion blender until smooth.
- 4. Fill mixture in mason jars with lids, and store in refrigerator for a few hours.
- 5. Serve on bread or crackers.
